

## The Yarmouth (Isle of Wight) Harbour Commissioners Notice to Mariners Yarmouth Harbour

## REPAIR WORKS ON YARMOUTH PIER

No: 06/2018 Date: 29 January 2018

NOTICE is hereby given that essential maintenance works will be commencing on Yarmouth Pier on Thursday 1 February 2018.

Marine plant and crew will be working alongside the Pier.

The works are expected to last approximately 4 months. A Notice to Mariners will be issued on completion of the works.

The Pier Head F. R. lighted beacon in position 50° 42′.514 N 001°29.975 W will be removed for the duration of the works.

An exclusion zone of 30 metres will be in force for the duration of the works (refer to Fig 1).

Three yellow special beacons listed below will mark the exclusion zone in the vicinity of the Pier Head and will be on station from Monday 29 January 2018 for the duration of the works.
