# LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

## NO. 8 OF 2014

### **MAINTENANCE DREDGING WORKS - Winter 2014/15**

Notice is hereby given that from  $3^{rd}$  November 2014 maintenance dredging works will commence in the Lymington River.

#### Dredging areas this season will include:-

- The East Bank mooring area in Horn Reach, i.e. from main Wightlink ferry berth downstream to the timber wave screens.
- The western margins of the navigation channel in 'Short Reach' between 'Cocked Hat' Beacon and No. 8 Buoy.
- The Dan Bran Pontoon (visitor side)
- Berthon Marina.
- Lymington Yacht Haven

The Dredging Barges ZH33 (Operator – Lymington Yacht Haven), and G63 (Operator – Berthon Boat Company) will be undertaking the works and shall maintain a listening watch on VHF12.

All mariners/harbour users are requested to pass the works operation with caution and at a speed consistent with safe navigation and minimal wash. Dredging platforms may be left on station overnight if outside of the navigation channel and appropriately lit.

Works are expected to continue until the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015 when this notice will self cancel.
