Sunday 2nd June 2019 Notice of Race & Supplemental Sailing Instructions

HWP 11:36hrs BST (4.4m)

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Organising Authority is The Royal Solent Yacht Club (RSYC)

2. RULES

- 2.1 Racing will be governed by the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 2020(RRS), the RSYC Standard Sailing Instructions 2019, and these Supplemental Sailing Instructions. In cases where there is conflict between the Notice of Race, and/or the Club's Standard Sailing Instructions (SSI), and/or the Supplemental Sailing Instructions; the Supplemental Sailing Instructions or failing that the Standard Sailing Instructions shall prevail.
- 2.2 In addition to the changes made to the RRS by the SSI, RRS 35 is changed by these Sailing Instructions 6.1
- 2.3 Class Rules shall apply except as changed by the SSI.

4. **STARTING LINE**

- 4.1 Starts will be from Grants.
- 4.2 For the Gaffer Class, SSI 9.2(b) is changed in that the outer limit mark will be an orange inflatable mark with ROYAL SOLENT YACHT CLUB thereon located approximately 600 metres northwards of the signal staff, and 150 metres northwards from No 9 buoy.

5. **FINISHING LINE**

5.1 When the first boat in the race fails to complete the course by the time limit, the results of the race will be determined by the placing of the boats through the start/finish line when '\(\pi\'\) is a mark of the course and SSI 10.1(c) and 10.1(d) do not apply.

6. TIME LIMIT

6.1 RRS 35 and SSI 10.1 is varied in that: the Time Limit for all classes is 1300 hrs with no exceptions.

7. SCORING

7.1 The race will be scored as provided in RRS Appendix A using the Low Point system.

HANDICAPPING

8.1 Handicaps, if appropriate, will be determined by the Racing Sub Committee or its nominee; and may be posted on the board in the Club prior to racing.

9. SAFETY/RISK STATEMENT/INSPECTION/ INSURANCE

9.1 Attention is drawn to SSI 14.

- 10.1 Prize giving will take place at the Club as soon as is practicable after racing.
