# YARMOUTH ONE DESIGN CLASS

## NOTICE OF RACE 2017

## 1. NAME

1.1. The name of the Class shall be the 'Yarmouth One Design Class'

#### 2. Organising Authority

2.1. The Organising Authority is the Royal Solent Yacht Club

#### 3. GOVERNING RULES

- 3.1. Racing will be governed by the Rules as defined in the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association(RYA), the RSYC Standard Sailing Instructions 2017, the regulation of the Yarmouth One Design Class (YOD) rules except as any of these are changes by the Sailing Instructions and any Supplemental Sailing Instructions. In the event of conflict, this Notice of Race and the Supplemental Sailing Instructions will prevail; RRS 63.7 shall not apply.
- 3.2. It is a condition of entry that all owners or persons in charge shall have completed, signed and returned the RSYC Condition of Entry Form.
- 3.3. Boats shall comply with YOD Rule number 10.

The following shall be aboard at all times:

- An operational VHF radio capable of operating on Channel M1 (37);
- 1 anchor weighing 20lb or thereabouts;
- Pair of oars and rowlocks or set of paddles;
- A bilge pump;
- 1 bucket;
- Lifejackets for each member of crew;
- At least 2 hand held flares;
- A lead line or sounding stick is optional.
- 3.4. The use of electronic navigation aids while racing is not permitted.

#### 4. SAILING DIRECTIONS

Boats will race in accordance with sailing directions issued by the Royal Solent Yacht Club.

### 5. Inspection

If the Sailing Committee consider it desirable they shall be entitled to inspect and measure any boat, and order any alterations they may consider advisable to bring her into uniformity with the other Class boats. Such alterations to be carried out at the expense of the owner.

#### 6. CREW

- 6.1. The crew is limited to three, but this number may be increased to four at the discretion of the Sailing Committee, in the case of children 14 years and under.
- 6.2. One paid hand is allowed but they must not touch the tiller during a race.

### 7. RISK STATEMENT

7.1. Rule 4 of the RRS states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat, and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the race organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
- It is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held for the event.

## 8. Insurance

8.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of f2,000,000 (two million pounds) per event or the equivalent.

# SUPPLEMENTAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

#### SCORING

Events will be scored using Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing in accordance with the Low Point Systems and RRS Appendix A 9. ( $1^{st} = 1$ point,  $2^{nd} = 2$  Points,  $3^{rd} = 3$  points, etc.).

Boats that come to the starting area, but are to be scored DNS, OCS, BFD, DNF, RAF or DSQ will be scored points for finishing place one more than the number of all boats that came to the starting area. This alters RRS Appendix A 4.2. Boats to be scored DNC will be scored 10 points.

Three races on the Sunday and Wednesday Series shall be completed to constitute a valid series. When more than three races have been completed in any series, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. However, when fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. (See separate Notice of Race and Supplemental Sailing Instructions for the Sunset Series).
