Needles Relief: 11 December 2021

The complete notice of race for this event is a combination of the General Club Notice of Race, this Supplement to the Notice of Race and this Entry Form.

The racing area for this event will be: The Lymington River; the Western Solent and its approaches; and Christchurch Bay.

Notes:

- A. There will not be a helicopter exercise this year, but a lifeboat exercise is planned to start about 12.00 noon. Boats finishing must keep clear of the lifeboats.
- **B.** The Royal Lymington Yacht Club would like to thank the Royal Solent Yacht Club for its assistance.
- **C.** This race is in the tradition of the past "Christmas Relief" of the manned Needles Lighthouse by the Royal Lymington Yacht Club.
- **D.** The race will take place on Saturday 11th December 2021, starting by the Clubhouse and using the usual <u>finish</u> line as the start line (to give more room for manoeuvring in the river).
- **E.** The race will have a staggered start, Class One starting first this year, followed by Class Two. This is NOT A PURSUIT RACE. Competitors are reminded that the speed limit above the Wave Barrier is 4 knots. The speed limit in the Lymington River is 6 knots.

- **G.** There is no reserve date.
- H. THIS RACE IS INTENDED TO BE CONDUCTED IN A SPIRIT OF CHRISTMAS GOODWILL.

EF1. Rules

- **EF1.1.** For Class One entries, World Sailing Offshore Regulations (WSOSR) Category 4 shall apply.
- **EF1.2.** RRS 52, Manual Power, shall not apply.
- **EF1.3.** The following Class flags must be displayed prominently near a boat's stern: Class One, numeral pennant 1; Class Two, numeral pennant 2. Boats not displaying a Class flag will be assumed not to be racing and will not be recorded.
- **EF1.4.** The personal flotation devices carried on board for each member of the crew shall conform to the appropriate standard and have a minimum buoyancy level of 50N or 150N.

EF2. Advertising

EF2.1. No event advertising is required by the organising authority.

EF3. Eligibility and Entry

EF3.1. The following classes are eligible:

Class Two: numeral pennant 2	0.999 and below	£15	3

The Sailing Instructions may amend the handicap range for each Class.

- **EF3.2.** If there are insufficient entries for Class 1, the Class 1 entries will be combined with Class 2 and will race the Class 2 course within the Western Solent. If there are insufficient entries for Class 2, boats will be asked to cruise to Yarmouth.
- **EF3.3.** Class 1 boats may be set a course out of the Solent. Class 1 boats not wishing to go out of the Solent may enter Class 2. For Class 1 boats exercising this option, **PLEASE MAKE THIS CLEAR ON THE ENTRY FORM**, attached.
- **EF3.4.** The Race Committee reserves the right to refuse entry or to allocate any boat to either Class.
- **EF3.5.** The base handicaps for the Lymington Adjusted Handicap (LAH) system are determined by the Race Committee. A boat entering under this handicap system shall complete and submit a handicap form (available with the entry form or on the Club website), unless the boat has previously been assigned a handicap and has not subsequently changed the boat, rigging or sail measurement in a way that could materially affect the boat's performance.
- **EF3.6.** The Race Committee reserves the right to alter a boat's handicap.
