Notice of Race & Supplemental Sailing Instructions for Keelboats

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

- 1.1 The Organising Authority is The Royal Solent Yacht Club.

2. RULES

- 2.1 Please refer to the RSYC SSI section 2.
2.2 RRS 35 (time limits) is changed by 5 herein.
2.3 Class Rules shall apply except as changed by the SSI.

3. ENTRY AND ENTRY FEES

- 3.1 An entry form should be completed online via the RSYC website together with the payment of **£15** entry fee **prior to racing**.

4. SCHEDULE OF RACES/TIMES AND SIGNALS

- 4.1 There will be a series of four races, with one race on each day. The race committee may add additional races if some races are lost due to inclement weather.

- 4.2 Start times on Wednesday will be as for the Wednesday Evening Series Supp SI 5.

5. TIME LIMIT

- 5.1 **RRS 35 and SSI 10.1a) are changed:** The time limit for all classes is **two hours after the start**, except for Wednesday evening when the time limit will be as WER SSI section 8.

6. SCORING

- 6.1 Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A “Low Point System”, except that the score for DNC will be decided by the Race Committee. Two Races are required to constitute a valid series. Each boat’s series score will be the total of her race score.
6.2 The scores for Race 3 (Wednesday 19th August) will also count in the Royal Solent Yacht Club Wednesday Evening Series 3 Race 3.

8. PRIZE GIVING & PRIZES

- 8.1 Trophies to be awarded:
- The Black Rock Trophy: awarded to the XOD/YOD boat placed first overall when scored together, presented at the prizegiving dinner on September 23rd.
 - XOD: Henderson Vase and Madcap Trophy(awarded at the XOD class dinner)
 - YOD: Sunset Trophy (awarded at the YOD class dinner)
 - Folkboat: Otter Trophy (awarded at the FB class dinner)

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

2. RULES

3. ENTRY AND ENTRY FEE

4. SCHEDULE OF RACES/TIMES

- 4.1 There will be a series of eight races with at least one race each day, the race committee may run additional races if any races are lost to inclement weather.
- 4.2 Two races are required to constitute a series
- 4.3 There will be a briefing for all competitors at 5pm at the RSYC each day and racing will begin as soon as possible after this.
- 4.4 The course will be displayed on a white board on the lawn of the RSYC or transmitted verbally from the committee boat or from a support RIB.
- 4.5 Racing will take place in Bouldnor Bay.
- 4.6 Classes will include laser full rig, laser radial, laser 4.7 and pico race, and races will start in that order. Classes may be combined if the race committee so decides.
- 4.7 The first race on Wednesday 19th will count in the RSYC Wednesday Evening laser series 3 (this just refers to lasers not the pico race fleet).

5. CLASS FLAGS

- 5.1 The class flags shall be as follows:

Laser	flag R
Laser radial	flag U
Laser 4.7	flag D
Pico	flag V

6. SCORING

- 6.1 A minimum of 2 or more races must be completed to constitute a series.
- 6.2 Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A low points system as changed by:
- When fewer than 5 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her scores.
 - When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be, subject to RRS 90.3(b), the total of her race scores excluding her worst score and when 8 or more races have been completed, a boat will score the total of all her races excluding her worst 2 scores.
- 6.3 Subject Tie: if after discard, two or more boats have the same points total the tie will be broken in accordance with RRS Appendix A8

8. PRIZE GIVING AND PRIZES

8.1 There will be a prize giving on the RSYC lawn as soon as possible after racing on Thursday 20th August.

8.2 Trophies will be awarded to the overall winner in:

- The laser full rig class
- The laser radial class
- The laser 4.7 class
- The Pico race class
- Veteran Laser Cup – best place laser or laser radial sailor aged 50 or over
