Club Boats

TB: *Solent RIB* is ready to be anti-fouled and launched this week. Modifications to the trailer are complete. *Countdown* has been in the RYB shed for her hull to be repainted. Engine work has had a temporary fix which will make her workable for this season, TB to re-assess at the end of the year.

Marksmen engine work is complete, ready to be installed. Requires a run in period with low revs.

There is much re-sealing required and TB will work on her once Spring Series is underway.

All race marks sponsors have renewed their support for 2025, buoys are all now repainted.

Biltmore have been slow with their printing so TB is concerned buoys wont all be ready for the Spring Series but will chase. New stickers are needed for #2, #5, #7 and #9.

BL reported on #5; Jeremy Rogers are sponsoring in 2025, Contessa 26 association will sponsor in 2026 and it is hoped that the Contessa 28s will sponsor in 2027.
